

tmux cheatsheet

As configured in [my dotfiles](#).

start new:

```
tmux
```

start new with session name:

```
tmux new -s myname
```

attach:

```
tmux a # (or at, or attach)
```

attach to named:

```
tmux a -t myname
```

list sessions:

```
tmux ls
```

kill session:

```
tmux kill-session -t myname
```

In tmux, hit the prefix `ctrl+b` and then:

⌘ Sessions

```
:new<CR> new session
```

```
s list sessions
$ name session
```

Windows (tabs)

```
c          new window
,          name window
w          list windows
f          find window
&          kill window
.          move window - prompted for a new number
:movew<CR> move window to the next unused number
```

Panes (splits)

```
% horizontal split
" vertical split

o swap panes
q show pane numbers
x kill pane
␣ space - toggle between layouts
```

Window/pane surgery

```
:joinp -s :2<CR>  move window 2 into a new pane in the current window
:joinp -t :1<CR>  move the current pane into a new pane in window 1
```

```
d detach
t big clock
```

```
